

# Fall Fiber Festival 2019 – Artwork Competition



## Calling Artists of all Ages...

The 2019 Fall Fiber Festival and Montpelier Sheep Dog Trials, an annual, local fiber festival, will be held on October 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at James Madison's Montpelier in Orange County, Virginia. The Festival Committee is soliciting artwork to be considered for the cover of the 2019 catalog, as well as on promotional items.

The winning selection will be chosen by the Fall Fiber Festival Committee and will be notified by email by late June. Winning artist will be offered a "meet the artist" display (10' X 10') at the entrance of the festival. The winning entry will receive a prize of **\$500**, honorable mentions will receive **\$100** and all will have their bio and artwork featured on the website and printed in the 2019 Festival Catalog!

## Rules and Information:

1. Art should be greyscale or black and white (preferably pen and ink).
2. Art must be no larger than 8"x11".
3. Art must reflect the theme of the festival by including one or all of the following: Fiber animals (sheep, goats, alpacas, rabbits, llamas, etc), working border collies, fiber tools (spinning wheels, weaving looms, knitting needles, etc), or items made of fiber (sweaters, blankets, mittens, etc).
4. Please do not include text in your design.
5. Winning artwork will become property of the Fall Fiber Festival & Sheep Dog Trials, Inc.

**Deadline for artwork submissions is midnight May 31, 2019. Late submissions may or may not be accepted at the discretion of the Fall Fiber Festival Committee.**
